- What's the big idea?
- Jesus is the son of God and he died for our sins and we must place our faith in him to be saved.
 - John 1:1,14
 - Jesus is God in the Flesh. He came to earth so that man could know him.
 - John 14:6
 - Jesus claimed to be the way, the truth, and the life.
 - How important is it to put our faith in him? No one comes to the Father without that faith.
 - Mk 3:7-12
 - He taught, he healed, he cast out demons.
 - Mk 4:35-41
 - He did miracles against the norms of the natural world in order to build faith in him as the son of God. His question: Do you still have no faith. No faith in what? In him!
 - Col 1:15-20
 - He is the image of God, the creator of the heavens and the earth, he is eternal, and holds all things together. All of God's fullness lives in him and through him God made peace with man through Jesus' death on the cross.
 - Rom 3:22-26
 - Faith in Christ's sacrifice is essential to being redeemed.
 - Mk 10:42-45
 - Jesus knew why he had come: to give his life as a ransom. He paid for us with his own life so that we could be free.
 - Mk 14:27-15:41
 - Jesus was crucified and raised to life for you.
 - Isaiah 53
 - This was written some 700 years before Christ.
 - Its all about his redeeming work.
 - 1Pet 2:21-25
 - Why did he die? That we might die to sins and live for righteousness.
